PREACHING

The Lenten conferences, *In the Desert with Jesus*, were preached by Br. Humbert Kilanowski, Br. Mannes Matous, Br. John Dominic Bouck, and Br. Luke Hoyt. During the spring recess, student brothers traveled to the campus ministries of Providence College in Providence, RI, and Aquinas House (at Dartmouth College) and St. Denis Parish in Hanover, NH, where they engaged in a variety of pre-Lenten preaching engagements and pastoral activities.

Led by *Dominicana* blog editor, Br. Henry Stephan, the friar Contributors of *Dominicana* staged a friendly take-over of the *Jesuit Post* (a comparable blog written by Jesuit seminarians) on April Fool's Day.
